Rewards and sanctions

We have high expectations of behaviour at Springfields First School. The behaviour of the children is excellent.

- At Springfields we reward good behaviour, hard work and attainment with stickers and certificates.
- We also have a common behaviour system that runs throughout the school using a traffic light system with green cards showing when good behaviour is displayed, amber warning cards and red cards when inappropriate behaviour has been. Sanctions within school vary from moving seats within the class, missing part of playtime to parents being invited into school to discuss their child's behaviour.
- We also have extra class reward systems. For example, I award raffle tickets with a chance to be picked out of the prize box on Fridays. I also have a class jar where the aim is to fill it with cubes so that when it is full, we have a class treat!

Broad and Balanced Curriculum

At Springfields First School, we believe that learning should be fun, purposeful and challenging.

Through our effective curriculum, we aim to equip each child with the skills they need for lifelong learning.

Despite restrictions imposed due to Covid-19, we are working hard to find ways to ensure our children can still engage creatively and practically- e.g use of 'active maths' linking maths skills with PE.

Homework

We try to make homework relevant to the children and reflective of what they are learning in their classroom. We aim to give the children a variety of activities that may challenge them with new learning or may practise skills already learnt in class.

- Each child will have a set day every week for changing their school reading books and library books. Please could children bring their reading books and diary every day. We expect reading diaries to be signed by a parent each week before books are changed.
- Our main homework day will be Friday sent out using Microsoft Teams -children will be taught how to log in and access their homework.
- Homework may include a task related to the topic we're currently learning about.
- Spellings/Maths facts will be set at half termly intervals to practise.
- Times tables practice. TT Rockstars- for home and school practice is recommended.

Additional information

- PE days are Tuesday and Friday. Children come to school in appropriate kit.

Reminder-

- Homework day is on Friday.
- Children need their reading diaries every day.
- Please encourage your child/ children to take more responsibility for their school equipment now they are in KS2 (juniors)- P.E. kits, homework, looking after school uniform etc.
- Visits- there will be no external educational visits this term- Covid-19 restrictions.
- Standon Bowers (year 4) residential- Spring Term- may be booked provisionally but as yet, government guidance states that there are to be 'no overnight stays'.
