Rewards and sanctions

We have high expectations of behaviour at Springfields First School. The behaviour of the children is excellent.

- At Springfields, we reward good behaviour, hard work and attainment with team points, stickers and certificates in Celebration assembly on Friday.
- We have a common behaviour system that runs throughout the school using a traffic light system with green cards showing when good behaviour is displayed, amber warning cards and red cards when inappropriate behaviour continues.
- Sanctions within school vary from moving seats within the class, to missing part of playtime or to missing 5 minutes of Golden Time for each red card. Parents may also be invited into school to discuss their child's behaviour.
- We also have extra class reward systems so, in Barn Owls, we award raffle tickets which provide the chance to be pick out a small prize the prize box on Fridays. We also have the 'Class Hero' trophy which we award to someone who has shown positive learning attitudes during the week.

- Please provide a red hoodie and black tracksuit bottoms for your child to wear where possible we will go outside for games lessons. Hair should be tied back and no jewellery should be worn.
- Please ensure that if home-time arrangements are different to normal that you let school know in writing or by phone.
- Please encourage your child to take more responsibility for their school equipment now that they are KS2 (Juniors) – PE kits, homework, looking after school uniform etc. This independence will really benefit your child when they go to middle school.
